- If your website is hosted on Google Business Profile, prepare for redirection to your Business Profile.

#### For Those Without a Google Business Profile Website:

If you don't currently utilize a Google Business Profile website, these changes do not affect you. However, it's an excellent opportunity to evaluate your online presence and consider establishing or updating your website.

#### **Recommended Website Builders:**

Considering a new website? Google recommends several user-friendly site-building platforms, including Wix, Squarespace, GoDaddy, Google Sites, Shopify, and WordPress. Each offers unique features suitable for various needs, from e-commerce to blogging.

#### Manage Your Ads and Domains:

- Ads Campaigns: Update any ads linked to a Google Business Profile website before March 1, 2024, to avoid interruptions.
- **Custom Domains:** If you're forwarding a custom domain to your Google Business Profile site, ensure you update the redirection to a new website before June 10, 2024.



While not officially baked in yet, Google's SGE is experimental is only accessible to limited people in the United States and is currently offered exclusively in English. If you are located in the U.S., you can attempt to activate it while browsing.

#### Will it affect all search queries?


Google's Search Generative Experience (SGE) is designed to enhance the search experience by generating more conversational and comprehensive responses to search queries. However, since it is still experimental, whether it affects all search queries depends on various factors such as the nature of the query, the user's location, the language of the query, and whether Google has rolled out SGE for that particular type of query or in that specific region.

We did our own experiments across different types of search queries and found that this **should not affect direct local search queries.** Informational queries are likely to be affected.


For example, a search for "Roofing Contractor San Antonio TX" did not bring up SGE result at the top as opposed to "Things to Consider Before Selecting a Roofing Contractor in San Antonio TX".

#### Query → Things to Consider Before Selecting a Roofing Contractor in San Antonio




#### How do you prepare for this change?

# Now, You Can Generate High-quality, Photorealistic Images Using Google Bard


Google recently announced an update about Google Bard. You can now generate high-quality, photorealistic images for free using Google Bard. This new update is available in English in most countries.

Bard's image generation relies on a model known as Imagen 2. According to Google, Imagen 2 is designed to produce high-quality, photorealistic outputs. As a result of the provided images, Bard's generated images effectively fulfill this commitment.

You need to note that all images created with Bard will be marked with a SyntID digital watermark. Also, Google has issued a warning that Bard will limit violent, offensive, and sexually explicit content. Google will also try to avoid generating images of named people using filters.
